**When:** Thursday 5th March 2015 from 10 to 11:30 am

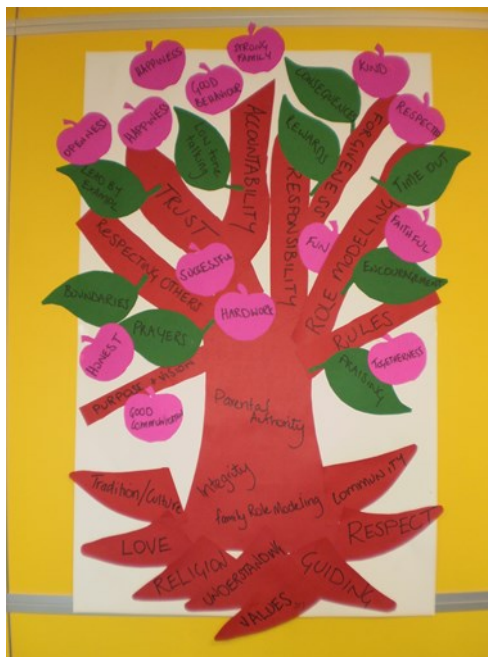

Dan came to Australia in 1979 from Vietnam after having spent some months in a Malaysian refugee camp. This experience, along with his work in the Vietnamese community subsequent to this, has been instrumental in providing Dan with a deep understanding and knowledge of social issues faced by refugee communities, in particular the Vietnamese community. Dan holds a Bachelor of Psychology degree with honours, and has clinical experience in the areas of relationships and addiction including gambling and substance abuse. He has worked with clients from mainstream, Indigenous and culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds. He has held community positions such as Vice President of the Vietnamese Youth Club and in more recent years Vice President of the Queensland Chapter of the Vietnamese Community in Australia. In his current role as Capacity Building Officer with the Queensland Program of Assistance to Survivors of Torture and Trauma, Dan enhances the capacity of a range of service providers who work with clients from refugee backgrounds, through project collaborations and the provision of consultation and training.
