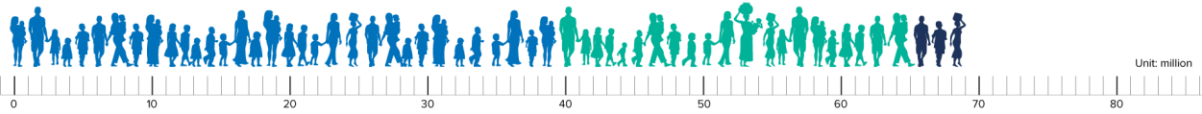

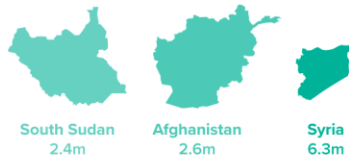

Where the world's displaced people are being hosted

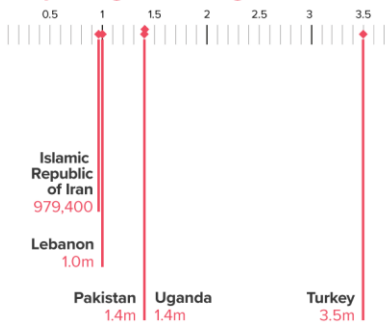


85 per cent of the world's displaced people are in developing countries

We are funded almost entirely by voluntary contributions, with 87 per cent from governments and the European Union and 10 per cent from private donors

*We are now witnessing the highest levels of displacement on record. An unprecedented **68.5 million** people around the world have been forced from home. Among them are nearly **25.4 million** refugees, over half of whom are **under the age of 18**.*

*There are also an estimated **10 million stateless people** who have been denied a nationality and access to basic rights such as education, healthcare, employment and freedom of movement.*
